

Sub: Rule 8 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960 – regarding.

Sir/ Madam,

Rule 8 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960 reads as below: -


"Information to be supplied by occupants of dwelling-houses – The registration officer may, for the purpose of preparing of roll, send letters of request in Form – 4 to the occupants of dwelling-houses in the Constituency or Part thereof, and any person receiving such letter shall furnish the information called for therein to the best of his ability."

In pursuance of provisions of rule 8, the Commission has been issuing standard guidelines that if a BLO/enumerator finds a particular house locked or that no adult member of the house is available at the time of his visit, he shall visit that house at least three times on different occasions. If even after three such visits, he finds the house locked or is not able to meet any adult member of the household, he will report the matter to his Supervisor, who will himself visit that house to verify the fact. In case he also finds the house locked or no adult member of the household is available, he shall drop the 'letter of request', in Form – 4 attached to Registration of Electoral Rules, 1960 (copy enclosed) in the premises and collect that Form in the next visit to that house and keep a proper account of it.

The Commission reiterates that during house to house survey by a BLO whether during intensive revision or any other type of revision, the above instruction will be followed *mutatis mutandis*.

The receipt of this letter may kindly be acknowledged and a copy of the instructions issued in this behalf be endorsed to the Commission.
