4 ..... 3.11.11	<p>This is the 4<sup>th</sup> hearing on WP no. 9085(w) of 2011 in the matter of Smt. Puspa Rani Maity and others. Shri Subrata Maity on behalf of Petitioner Smt. Pusparani Maity has filed hazira that I accepted.</p> <p>Sk. Samsul Islam, Karmadhyakshya( Bidyut), Nandigram-I PS, Shri Sanat Kumar Biswas, BL&amp;LRO Nandigram-I, Sk. Khusnabi, Pradhan, Samsabad Gram Panchayat, Sk. Nijimuddin Khan, Proprietor of Supreme India and Shri Abhirup Bose, Zilla Parishad are present.</p> <p>Sk. Samsul Islam, Karmadhyakshya( Bidyut), Nandigram-I PS is reportedly the public functionaries looking after the PMGSY work in that area. Shri Abhirup Bose, Secretary Zilla Parishad representing Zilla Parishad as the authority responsible for carrying out the PMGSY work. Shri Subrata Dutta, Superintending Engineer represents P&amp;RD department.</p> <p>As per Memo no. 967 dated 01.11.11 of BLLRO Nandigram-I, there is an encroachment of 3.5 decimal on plot no. 725. As per letter dated 18.11.2011, Shri Subrata Maity has submitted a list of 5 trees along with approximate value that were reportedly cut while the road work constructed.</p> <p>In the last order dated 02.11.2011, it was ordered that petitioner and local functionaries will settle the matter amicable after a joint meeting. This opportunity was given in the interest of ensuring justice and also for getting the work executed at an early date. It is hereby reiterated that public road will serve the interest of common residents of that area. However, the meeting has not reportedly been held and the petitioner has reiterated their request for compensation in terms of BLLRO's report and in terms of their claim of cutting down trees on the said land. Report of the BLLRO, Nandigram-I and the letter seeking compensation for cutting trees is made part of the order sheet.</p> <p>I am therefore, of the opinion that in pursuance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 20.06.2011, the LA Collector, Purba Medinipur will value the land that has reportedly been encroached as per BLLRO along with valuation of the trees.</p> <p>Thereafter the appropriate department in the government shall make payment of compensation to the land holders. Matter is closed hereby.</p> <p>All are Informed accordingly.
